The purpose of this Research Symposium is to provide a forum to showcase research advances and programmatic innovations regarding global non-communicable diseases (NCDs) within the framework of the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), with a specific emphasis on health targets in SDG 3:

Priority will be given to early career investigators within 5 years of their terminal degree.

The Research Symposium is embedded within a meeting of US investigators and their global collaborators; it will include plenary sessions and technical workshops related to the global NCDs and the SDGs.

Abstracts on any global NCD research issue will be considered. Research on the intersection of NCDs and topics related to targets specified by SDG #3 are highly encouraged. We welcome abstracts that describe approaches to reducing NCD mortality in low- and middle-income countries (LMICs); NCD prevention interventions or policy; NCD surveillance systems; health financing; or the intersection of NCD research with other topical areas, such as HIV.
